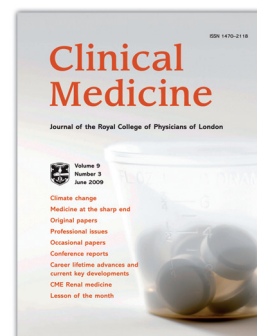

**Clinical Medicine** is the journal of the Royal College of Physicians. It is unique in providing a combination of up-to-date clinical articles across the medical specialties as well as addressing a wide range of professional issues. The journal seeks to encourage high standards of medical care by promoting good clinical practice and influencing policy. **Clinical Medicine** is aimed at practising physicians with medical commitments in the UK and overseas, and has relevance to all those managing or working within the healthcare sector.



- **Professional issues** – covering areas that influence clinical practice, including ethics, legal issues, professional regulation, impact of government proposals, training, relationships with primary care and developments in Europe.
  - **Career lifetime advances and current key developments** – experienced clinicians describe the advances that have occurred in their specialty, with additional contributions from younger colleagues who describe current key developments.
  - **Wider horizons in medicine** – contributors write about their experiences in unconventional spheres of clinical medicine.

  - **Continuing Medical Education (CME)** – this highly acclaimed feature is published in full colour and comprises a rolling programme to cover the major medical disciplines. A group of authoritative review articles on a selected specialty are published in each issue, with a related self-assessment questionnaire. Answers, which are submitted online, allow physicians to gain a maximum of seven external and five personal CPD credits each year towards their continuing professional development requirements.
