# Why Do GIM

- Travel of direction
- Increased job availability
- Allows you to work in Europe

# Addition Points

- Not time based
- Relevant throughout training
- Need to show constant engagement

# ARCP Process

- Stage 1
- Stage 2
- PYA (Need to prepare a presentation)
- CCT

# ARCP Requirements

- Follow GIM ARCP Decision Aid
- Up to date ALS
- GIM ES Report (For each ARCP stage, Must be separate to your Speciality ES report, Must comment on your GIM experience, Needs to be within 3 months of your ARCP date)
- FIRTH Calculator (Acute & Outpatient experience – ES to validate numbers in report)
- MSF – minimum of 3 Consultants & ideally include a Non-parent speciality Consultant; all responses must be within a 3 month period of each other)

# Stage 1

- Emergency & Part A Procedures to be individually signed off by ES & Self
- CMT DOPS do NOT count
- Common, Top 20, Other – Group sign off by ES & Self

# Stage 2

- Stage 2
  - ✓ Follow GIM Decision Aid
  - ✓ Ensure competencies: Common, Top 20, Other signed at current level of training by ES & Self
  - ✓ Held same day as your PYA



# PYA

- PYA (SEPARATE PROCESS)
- ✓ Lead by External
- ✓ 100 hr GIM teaching summary
- ✓ Patient Survey
- ✓ GIM Audit/QIP
- ✓ Leadership & Management Course
- ✓ Formal Teaching Course
- ✓ CCU/ICU Experience
- ✓ Register with the RCP diary
- ✓ 3 minute presentation
- ✓ Be prepared to be given additional time – think carefully before planning post-CCT fellowships/plan

# CCT

- PYA Targets
- Decision Aid Requirements

# ARCP Tips

- Create a separate GIM ARCP Folder for EACH stage (1, 2, PYA, CCT (PYA Targets))
- Aim to attach at least 2 pieces of evidence to each curriculum item – predominantly SLEs)
- Assessments must be completed in HST – we have noted some trainees are linking old evidence from their CMT curriculum

# Other info.....

- ES can be the same for your Speciality & GIM (does not need to have a dual CCT in GIM)
- Speciality & GIM CCT Date will be the same

# Out of Programme

- Be prepared to 'refresh curriculum' – in particular Emergency Presentations & Part A Procedures
- Delayed ARCP
- Must get a standard outcome to pursue an OOP

# Resignation

- Can resign at any time – with or without competencies if leaving Medicine fully

# ARCP Outcomes

- Outcome 1 – Achieving progress and competencies at the expected rate
- **Outcome 6 – Gained all required competencies for the programme (CCT)**

# ARCP Outcomes

- Outcome 7 – for trainees out of programme or not in run through training
- Outcome 8 – for trainees Out of programme
  - ✓ OOPE (Experience)
  - ✓ OOPR (Research)
  - ✓ OOPC (Career Break)



# ARCP Outcome

- Outcome 2 – Development of specific competencies required – additional training time not required (Re-ARCP)
- Outcome 5 – Incomplete evidence presented – additional training time may be required

# ARCP Outcome

- Outcome 3 – Inadequate progress by the trainee – additional training time required
- Outcome 9 – Top up training
- **Outcome 4 – Released from training programme with or without specified competencies**

# What will we do to help

- TPD lunchtime attendance at GIM Training Days (Drop in session)
- Email Prompt sheet prior GIM ARCP (Stage specific)
- Interim ARCPS (4 weeks prior to ARCP Date)

- Funded by the Deanery
- Desirable to attend once in HST training
- Opportunity to complete SLEs in cases you have been directly involved with
- Certificate & attached list of GIM competencies achieved
- LRI based
- Attended by ALL GIM Trainees (including North East Midlands)

- Consultant led
- £150 per place
- Dates to follow for the academic year

# Chest Drain Course

- Based at Glenfield Hospital
- Consultant led
- £150 per place
- 1 course per year



# DC Cardioversion Session

- Based at LRI
- Half Day Session
- Free to attend
- Consultant & Cardio SPR led
- Theory session
- Practical session
- Certificate of completion issued
- 3x/Year

# Knee Aspiration Clinics

- Based in UHL
- Led by Rheumatologist
- Weekly clinics
- Email Clinic Co-ordinators/Consultants
- Check list beforehand to ensure knee aspiration available

# Ascitic Drain Opportunities

- Based at LRI, Ward 42/43
- Gastro SPR led
- Email SPRs directly

# SLE Clinics

- Based in GPAU, LRI
- Co-ordinated by myself (Email me directly)
- Consultant Led
- Unselected Acute Medicine take – Aim to curriculum map
- Good opportunity to complete ACATs/CBDs/Mini-CEXs

- Based at LRI (+/- Glenfield)
- College tutor & Associate College Tutor led
