Registration desk

You must register upon arrival. **The registration desk will open at 15.30** for you to register and collect your tickets. Your guests do not need to register. **Please note that the registration desk will close at 16.45.**

Late arrivals

Please be aware that any diplomats that do not register or arrive after the registration desk has closed will not be presented with a diploma. Diplomats who arrive after the president's procession will not be granted entrance to the Dorchester Library.

Dorchester gallery

Due to Health and safety regulations, you are allowed only one (1) guest to view the ceremony from inside the Dorchester Library gallery.

Viewing the ceremony from Wolfson Theatre

Your remaining guests will be able to view the ceremony live in the Wolfson Theatre where plenty of seating is available.

Please note that children under the age of 8 years old are not permitted to watch the ceremony from inside the Dorchester Library gallery.

Please also advise of any special needs or access requirements.

Standing buffet reception

The Royal College of Physicians is pleased to invite each new member free of charge to the buffet following the ceremony. Up to four guests are also eligible to attend at a charge of £35 each. Children under 12 years old will be free of charge. Please be aware that you have register to attend the buffet prior to the event.

Crèche facility

The crèche is run by experienced staff who will care for your children. The crèche can offer places to children between the ages of 6 months and 8 years and must be booked in advance as the places are limited. There is a £25 charge for each child and details (such as names and ages) need to be submitted 5 days before the date of the ceremony, including payment.
