

# Webconference summary: LUCADA made easy

Some of the issues raised were:

- **Consistency of process** is linked to better quality
- Need to **reduce room for error**
- **Human factors** can affect data collection
- Need to **identify what data** you need to be **collecting** and have a **clear plan** for collecting it
- The **type of software** that you chose can affect your ability to upload smoothly to LUCADA
