A diagnosis requires widespread pain > 3 months duration with currently either i) widespread pain index (WPI) \geq 7 and symptom severity scale (SSS) score \geq 5, or

ii) WPI 4–6 and SSS score \geq 9, with pain in 4/5 body regions (see text).
